Rules & Regulations

ENTRY FEES: \$30.00 per class pre-entry, \$35.00 post-entry.

For pre-entries, visit horseshowsonline.com

For all Classes \$5.00 of each entry fee added to the prize money and paid to four places: 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State law. Please bring an extra copy to leave with your entry.

SCHOOLING: In-ring schooling will be permitted 7:30-8:30 am. This will be strictly enforced. An outside schooling area is also available throughout the day.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Boots and breeches/jodhpurs are requested. Winter jackets and/or half chaps with paddock boots and breeches/jodhpurs are permitted. No jeans.

AWARDS: The judge's decisions are always final. Six ribbons per class. Prize money for each class with Champion and Reserve ribbons. Series year-end awards to be presented at the last show.

UNJUDGED ROUNDS: Will be allowed at the end of the classes, or as breaks occur, at regular entry fee.

Class Rules

Classes 1, 6, 7 scored under USEF Table IV.1. (speed). Optimum time.

Classes 2, 5, 8 scored under USEF Table IV sec. 2b (jump off). Optimum time.

Classes 3, 4, 9 scored under USEF Table IV sec. 2c (power and speed) Optimum time.

Classes 10, 13, 18, 19, 22, 27 scored under USEF Table II sec 2c (power and speed).

Classes 11, 14, 17, 20, 23, 26 scored under USEF Table II sec 2b (jump off).

Classes 12, 15, 16, 21, 24, 25 scored under USEF Table II sec 1 (speed).

Trying New Things: Open to horses and ponies. Riders may not cross-enter into any class exceeding 2'3". This class will have two poles set at 18" but will cross in the middle. Class will be optimum time.

Getting Into it: Open to horses and ponies. Riders may not cross-enter into any classes exceeding 2'3". This class will have a straight bar set at 18". Class will be optimum time.

Puddle Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Horses, ponies and riders may only cross-enter into any class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible.

Novice Jumper: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of Dec. 1 of the current show year. Horses and ponies in this division may only cross-enter into Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper if the rider is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper and any other class not exceeding 3'.

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of Dec. 1 of the current show year.

Riders may only cross-enter into Novice Jumper, if mount is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'.

Open Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences shall be 2'6" with spreads no greater than the height of the fence.

Low Jumper: Open to horses and ponies.

Thoroughbred Jumper: Open to registered Thoroughbreds and those eligible to be registered.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateur riders.
